



How to Access the Online Bronze Medallion/Cert II in Public Safety

Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) has a number of online courses available to support m and Powercraft. Skills Maintenance options are also available to be completed online.

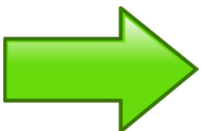
The online courses available typically cover the theory components, and are designed in activities and assessments organised by your surf life saving club or state centre to ach

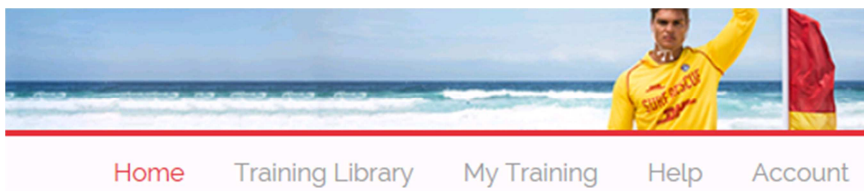

6. Click on “View Courses”
7. You will see “Bronze Medallion/Cert II Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)
8. Click on “Enrol”.
9. Click on “Process Payment” (NB: This course is free to club members)

10. You will receive an email from etrainu stating that you have been allocated the following course: Bronze Medallion/Cert II Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)
11. You can then commence the modules.
12. Once you have completed all the modules, print the online completion certificate and hand this to your trainer/assessor. It will look like this:

13. Assessment Portfolio – the club or your trainer/assessor will provide you with a 6 page assessment portfolio which you will both have sections to complete
14. The Assessor will then finalise paperwork, and submit to SLSQ for processing.
